In 1999, he established the Graham Design studio in San Francisco to offer a strategic approach to the design, development and marketing of furniture, lighting and related products for the contract, residential and hospitality markets. With deep roots in architecture and interior design, Graham's broad visual literacy allows him to orchestrate comprehensive programs as he has done for Decca, advising on the company's creative direction, as well as contributing product and showroom design.
